



# 2009 Hunter Harvested Venison Processor Registration Form

**NOTE: This application must be submitted and approved prior to processing any deer for the 2009 donation program**

The data on this form will be used to process your application. You must provide your Minnesota Tax ID number. If you do not have one, you must provide your social security number (MS Sec 270C.72). We are required by law to collect this information and we cannot grant your reimbursement without it. No one will have access to your social security number except those permitted access by law, your written consent, court order, or those department employees whose job duties require access. **If designation is granted under this application, it is hereby expressly agreed:**

- Plant operators must conduct an inspection of the carcass to determine that it is in a condition suitable for donation.
  - Deer can only be accepted with the hide intact.
  - Mishandled deer (exposed to a lack of refrigeration or contaminated carcasses) cannot be accepted.
  - Hunters must sign an affidavit indicating they have followed the deer handling guidelines in the "Field" to "Fork" brochure.
  - Any venison product not suitable for donation must be disposed of by acceptable means.
- Donated products must be identified with the following items:
  - "Hunted venison, for food donation only"
  - Plant identification number
  - Date of processing
  - "Not for sale"
- Processors must maintain logs of donations accepted and product distributed.
- Archery harvested venison may go directly to the food shelf with proper documentation.
- Firearm harvested venison must be held or transported to an approved storage facility. It will all be x-rayed prior to distribution to a designated food shelf.
- Carcasses from deer that have been tested for Chronic Wasting Disease must be held pending test results.
- All procedures as outlined in the registration material must be followed for processing fee reimbursement.
